Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risks and Indemnity Agreement

In consideration of being permitted to take part in the excursions, expeditions and mountain climbs, which may include, but are not restricted to walking trips around Canmore, Alberta, mountain hikes, climbs, and technical ascents on steep terrain in the Canadian Rockies, Purcell Range, and other mountain ranges in Canada, and the rest of the world during the days of

_____, (henceforth referred to as "Mountain Excursions") as conducted by Carlos P. Buhler, Altitude Journeys and Buhler Alpine Adventures, I agree to grant this release from liability of all claims and agree not to sue and to assume all risks of the Mountain Excursions that I will participate in.

A. I hereby waive any and all claims that I may now or in the future have against, and release from liability and agree not to sue Carlos P. Buhler, Altitude Journeys or Buhler Alpine Adventures, its owner(s), staff, servants, volunteers, and agents (collectively referred to as "Staff"), for any injury, death, property damage or loss including economic loss sustained by me as a result of my participation in the Mountain Excursions due to any cause whatsoever, including but not limited to negligence on the part of the Staff.

B. I am aware that the Mountain Excursions may be traveling to distant mountain ranges and have the usual inherent dangers, hazards and risks, which may include, but are not limited to:

1. Risk of injury, death or property damage due to collision or upset with natural wildlife, vehicles or other persons on route or at the location.
2. Rough and steep terrain where a slip or fall may cause injury, death, or property damage, such as sprains, pulled muscles or tendons, internal injuries, fractures, broken bones, cuts, and scrapes. Such areas may not have been examined as to potential dangers.
3. Unstable or unpredictable weather conditions, which may cause injury (hypothermia, sunstroke, sunburn, windburn, frostbite, high altitude sickness,

etc.), death, or property damage, and which may prevent travel to, from or within the area.

4. Unfamiliar terrain where I may become lost, get off route or become separated from the guide or the rest of the party.

5. Wild animals including but not limited to black and grizzly bears, moose, elk, deer, cougars, lynx, wolves, bighorn sheep, caribou mountain goats, fox, coyote, or other species, which are unpredictable and may attack without warning, resulting in injury, death or property damage.

6. Remote terrain, which may hamper or prevent communication and result in the delays in rescue, or the unavailability of prompt medical assistance.

7. The Staff of Buhler Alpine Adventures or other travelers, who by conduct including negligence, may cause injury, death or property damage.

8. Rough terrain, which may be covered by debris or other material obstacles and hazards including but not limited to rocks, tree roots or stumps, creek crossings, boulders, forest deadfall, or debris dislodged by natural causes and/or by other travelers and climbers.

I accept all the dangers and risks of the Mountain Excursions in and around the Mountain Parks of the Canadian Rockies and other mountain ranges of the world.

Participants under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian read, understand, and sign this agreement.

I, _____, confirm that I have read and understood the terms of this agreement prior to signing it and agree that this agreement will be binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, successors or assigns.
